What Is asexuality?

 Asexuality: A sexual orientation describing people who do not experience sexual attraction

 Asexual: Someone who experiences no sexual attraction and/or sexual desire for partnered sex

The Asexual Spectrum

 Grey-Asexual/ Greysexual: Someone who <u>very rarely</u> experiences sexual attraction

 Demisexual: Someone who cannot/ does not experience sexual attraction unless there is an emotional connection formed first

 - Aromantic
 - Biromantic
 - Panromantic
 - Polyromantic
 - Homoromantic
 - Heteromantic
 - Etc..

And its limits

The limits of "Myth busting"

- Asexual community is diverse
- Some of us do fit various stereotypes
- E.g. Some of us...
 - Are on the autistic spectrum
 - Deal with mental health concerns
 - Have physical disabilities
 - Are survivors of violence
 - Are trans and/or gender variant
- Someone's asexuality may or may not be related to these things

Why does this matter?

- Asexuality is not recognized as legitimate
 - Or as even existing
- Sex-centered and romance-centered values
 - Romantic love and/or sex= Humanity
 - Love = Sex (and vice versa)
 - Compulsory sexuality and pressure to conform, perform and put-out
- Recognition for asexual people's diverse relationships
